The first tournament of the year, sponsored by the **NNAC** and which provided the awards, was the **Trophy Rockfish Team Tournament on May 5 &6**, a team event in which the combined weight of the two largest fish entered by a team were counted with the winning results listed below:

The second tournament, sponsored by **RW's Sport Shop** and where winners can redeem their gift certificates, was the **Rock-A-Thon Tournament on May 26 & 27** for striped bass and croakers, and it was the first tournament counting for the Angler of the Year. Many anglers were asking, "Where'd they go?" in reference to the striped bass as only one member entered a fish for that species. There were a number of croakers entered, and the tournament winners are listed below:

Striped Bass

1st. Jan Jamrog – 2 lb, 11 oz

2nd. No other entries

Croaker

1st. Jan Jamrog – 1 lb, 5 oz (won tie-breaker)

2nd. Tom Smith – 1 lb, 5 oz

With his two first place wins, Jan has taken a sizable early lead in the AOY standings. First place winners in all tournaments are eligible for an NNAC plaque listing their accomplishment.

I particularly want to thank John O'Connor, Susan Hudson, and Dave Compton for organizing and hosting an exhibit at the **Reedville Fishing Derby** on May 12th, where the NNAC was represented with a table and picture displays at the Captains' meeting and where a new NNAC information flyer was inserted into the Captain's bags being distributed.
