The picnic was followed by the club meeting at the library in Kilmarnock where there were 26 members and 6 guests with 4 of the guests joining the club by the end of the meeting. The attendees were entertained and informed by two speakers. First, club member Frank Brewer demonstrated his set-up for flounder fishing with tips on wire line rods for drifting or trolling as well as techniques for jigging. Next, Capt. Ed Lawrence of Speckulater Charters used a computer slide presentation to help explain where to find speckled trout and how to catch them. He also showed his preferred tackle and lures for a stealthy presentation to these spooky fish.

The weather was good for the Target Ship Shoot-Out, which was sponsored by **Surfside Bait & Tackle** in Mechanicsville and by the NNAC and was held on June 23rd and 24th. The target species were bluefish, croaker, and flounder. The award winners are listed below:
