The hurricane cancelled the last scheduled day of the Striper Challenge Tournament, which was sponsored by the **Marine Electronics of Hartfield**, and results from Saturday, October 20th determined the outcome. The target species were striped bass and bluefish, and it appeared that these fish were more abundant in the northern fishing zones as only one fish was weighed at the five southernmost weigh stations. The award winners, (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>) who will receive gift certificates from Marine Electronics of Hartfield, are listed below:

### **Striped Bass**

1st Place – 5 lb, 1 oz by Jan Jamrog of Heathsville, VA weighed at Buzzard Pt. at 4:21 PM

2nd Place – 4 lb, 7 oz by Robert Kraft of Lovettsville, VA weighed at Smith Pt. at 2:50 PM

### **Bluefish**

1<sup>st</sup> Place – 3 lb, 0 oz by John O'Connor of Manassas, VA weighed at Buzzard Pt. at 4:21 PM

2<sup>nd</sup> Place – 2 lb, 11 oz by Steve Hedgpeth of Springfield, VA weighed at Smith Pt. at 4: 55 PM

The next order of business is to vote for NNAC officers and directors for next year.
