The Bonus Rockfish tournament, the last of the club's seven member tournaments for 2016, will be held over the weekend of November 26-27, weather permitting. Target species for the tournament are Rockfish only. Hopefully, the big ones will have arrived in the NNAC tournament fishing areas by then. Gift cards will be awarded for the top two fish (by weight), with the first place winner also receiving a plaque. AOY points will be awarded, with 4 points for first place, 3 for second, 2 for third and 1 point for all other entries.
